## The NoLinkRectangle action.

The NoLinkRectangle action is a very simple action. It removes the dotted rectangles that surround active links in Internet Explorer (solid blue on Mac). If you are one of the web designers who are frustrated over the impact the dotted rectangles have on your design, this action will be a great help in your work!

You can add onfocus="blur()" to every link tag to solve the problem, but with the NoLinkRectangle you just need one single head action in your page and the dotted rectangles are gone.

The NoLinkRectangle action removes the rectangles from graphic links, text links and image maps.

## Manual:

- 1. In layout mode drag a head action objects from the Objects > Smart tab to the head section of your page. If the head section isn't open click the little triangle in the upper left corner of your page window.
- 2. Highlight (select) the head action object.
- 3. Click the Action button in the action inspector and pick the NoLinkRectangle action from the list
- 4. Make sure the "Exec." in the upper left corner of the inspector is set to "OnLoad".
- 5. Done!
