

The LayerResize action.

The LayerResize action enables you to resize layers.

Restrictions:

Due to a bug in Mac IE5.0 I was forced to make a decision when writing this action, it would either work with layers set to an “absolute” position or layers set to a “relative” position. As “absolute” is used 99% of the time and it is GL’s default setting I chose the “absolute” setting. This problem might be solved in later versions of this action.

You can’t use this action as a head action set to run “onParse” The CSS might not have been parsed by the browser when the action code is executed, if that is the case the browser will throw a JavaScript error.

Manual:

1. Highlight a text link or graphic link.
2. In the action inspector click the new action button in the upper right corner.
3. Click the button that says “action”.
4. Pick the LayerResize action from the list.
5. Use the dropdown menu to select the layer you want to control.
6. Enter X and Y values.

Installation:

The action inspector looks like this:
